Prof. Aurelien Marabelle is a clinician-researcher with dual expertise in oncology and immunology, specializing in early-phase clinical trials of novel cancer immunotherapies. He is a senior medical oncologist at Gustave Roussy and leads the Translational Research Laboratory in Immunotherapy (LRTI) affiliated with INSERM and Université Paris-Saclay. His research focuses on mechanisms of immunotherapy action, resistance, adverse events, and biomarker development.

Prof. Jarushka Naidoo is a Professor of Medical Oncology and Chief of Thoracic Oncology at Beaumont RCSI Cancer Centre in Dublin, Ireland and Adjunct faculty at Johns Hopkins University. She is a clinical trialist and translational researcher focusing on NSCLC, immunotherapy and immune-related toxicity. Prof. Naidoo is an internationally recognized leader in the field of immunotherapy toxicity, having published many of the seminal papers on immune-related toxicity mechanisms, management and outcomes.
