“Antibody drug conjugates : construct, targets and activity across cancer types”

Dr Barbara Pistilli is an Associate Professor of Medical Oncology and Chair of the Breast Cancer Unit at Gustave Roussy, Villejuif, France. She leads a large translational program focusing on the identification of mechanisms of response and resistance to antibody drug conjugates across different tumor types, with a particular focus on breast and lung cancer.

“Cancer imaging : Evolutions and Revolutions”

Dr. Dow-Mu Koh is Consultant Radiologist at the Royal Marsden Hospital and Professor of Functional Cancer Imaging at the Institute of Cancer Research. His research interests include the development of novel MRI techniques for the assessment of cancers and, more recently, the development and testing of artificial intelligence tools for improving cancer care. He is currently the Director of the NIHR Cancer Research Facilities and co-Director of the Imaging Hub at the Royal Marsden Hospital. He is a Fellow of the International Society of Magnetic Resonance in Medicine, European Society of Gastrointestinal and Abdominal Imaging and the International Cancer Imaging Society.

Dr Elizabeth Smyth is a medical oncologist based in Oxford, UK who specializes in gastroesophageal cancer. Dr Smyth originally trained in Dublin, Ireland before moving to Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Centre for a 2 year fellowship in 2009. After returning to the UK in 2011, Dr Smyth has been active in clinical trials and translational research, both nationally and internationally. She is a member of the ESMO Upper GI faculty and the current co-chair of the EORTC Gastric Cancer Taskforce.
